

Beulah Plan to Restart Worship Services on Sunday May 17, 2020

Some Basic Assumptions

- Anyone who has been exposed to COVID-19 or is symptomatic should stay home and watch service on Facebook Live (and let church family know so we can all be praying for you).
- We encourage those at high risk from COVID-19 to continue to stay home and watch worship services on Facebook Live.
- Because we cannot practice social distancing in Sunday School areas, for the time being we will not have our Sunday School groups meet at 9:45 AM.
- Because we cannot practice social distancing with babies and young children in the nursery, we will not provide childcare.

Guidelines for All Attendees and Participants in Worship

- To practice Christlike love for each other, it is required that everyone wear a mask. We will do our best to have extra masks available at the entrances/exits, but **each person should bring their own mask** if possible.
- We will strive to have hand sanitizer dispensers and/or wipes at entrance/exits and outside / inside bathroom doorways for your convenience.
- Please do not linger in Foyer, Fox Trot or Hallway areas and enter the sanctuary as quickly as possible to locate a seat (Family units or other groups who come to worship together in the same vehicle should enter and exit together).
- Some pews will be blocked off to provide space between seating areas for sufficient social distancing.
- Please sit in family units or with the group you came to church in the same vehicle with as part of the social distancing precautions.
- Instead of passing the plates for the offering, offering plates will be placed at the entrances/exits so we may give our tithes and offerings as we enter or exit the service.

- Even though we will not provide childcare, **All Children Will Be Welcome** and be assured the little ones will be considered a blessing as always.
- In the same way that we enter the sanctuary as family units or as groups who came in the same vehicle, one of our deacons will dismiss us one unit/group at a time to exit from the service to help maintain social distancing precautions. Again, please do not linger in the Foyer, Fox Trot or Hallway areas.
